Ragging is unacceptable to the institute

July 25, 2007

“.....Ragging of any dimension is a criminal and non-bailable offence in our country. The legislations of the State and the Central government provide for stringent punishment including imprisonment. Once the involvement of a student is established in ragging, the offending student will be dismissed from the Institute and will not be admitted into any other institution. Avenues also exist for collective punishment, if individuals can not be identified in this inhuman act....

Our senior students have been very responsible and shown maturity in the past and we expect them to continue their good behaviour.....”
