Its SPINNING and not DRYING!

Sept. 4, 2007

We have installed 8 washing machines at some places selected randomly.

- 1. DO NOT Overload the spinner.
- 2. SPINNER IS 'SPINNER'. IT IS NOT DRIER. (ASK YOUR PARENTS).
- 3. THE SPINNER is supposed to dry the cloths upto 75% (with some hot blow). If you run the spinner for 2 minutes or 10 minutes, its not going to change the percentage of drying drastically.

 In contrast, when you run it for a long, you are using the heat of the spinner to heat the motor also. The motor has a thermostat; it will stop, if it finds the working temperature more than it should work at.
- 4. Please check that there are no COINS in the cloths before placing in the machines.

Therefore, dry the cloths in air after you spin for a minute or two.

Take it granted for me, if you do not listen to this, your spinner will go bad almost immediately.
